### SOCCER CHAMPIONSHIP 2011 (U-19) BOYS

#### (Rules & Regulations)

1. The Tournament will be called the Indian Public Schools Conference Soccer Championship – 2011 U-19 Boys.
2. The tournament will be held from 8<sup>th</sup> Oct to 12<sup>th</sup> Oct 2011. The teams should arrive on 7<sup>th</sup> Oct 2011 by 5:00pm.
3. The matches will be played according to S.G.F.I. & F.I.F.A rules.
4. Preliminary rounds will be played on League basis. The winner will be awarded 3 points, Loser nil & in case of a draw both teams will share 1 point each.
5. If a team gives their walkover, all the matches of that team will be nullified.
6. The top team or two top teams, depending on the number of entries and the pools; will qualify for the Knockout round.
7. If two teams tie with equal points in a pool, the ranking will be decided as follows :
  - (a) Goal Difference
  - (b) Toss will be there
8. At the Knockout state it shall be 35-10-35 & Semi Final & Final matches shall be 40-10-40; Tiebreaker rule will be applied.
  - (a) The referee shall choose the goal at which the penalty kicks have to be taken.
  - (b) The referee will toss a coin and the team whose captain wins the toss shall take penalty kick first.
  - (c) Five penalty kicks shall be taken alternatively by each team.
  - (d) If after both have taken five penalty kicks, each and both have scored the same number of goals, or have not scored any goal, then penalty kick continues to be taken in the order of 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and so on alternatively from each the same number of kicks.
9. If a school after sending its entry, wishes to withdraw from the tournament it shall, give a written request of its intention to do so at least seven days before the commencement of the tournament to the organizing school.
10. A team, if necessary, may have to play more than one match in a day. However, a team will not be asked to play two consecutive matches.
11. Teams must reach the ground 30 minutes before the start of a match. Failing which the team coming late to the ground may be disqualified.
12. In case, the two teams playing in a match have similar uniform of a similar colour, there will be a toss. The team losing the toss shall have to put on another outfit. Hence you are advised to bring two sets of uniforms to avoid last minute hassle. The organizing committee, in case of non-availability of another outfit shall provide one, which the player will have to wear during the match. T-Shirts must be numbered.
13. Protest, if any, will be lodged with the organizing secretary in writing with 30 minutes after the match is over with a protest fee of Rs.1000/- (refundable if the protest is upheld & with proof).
14. The organizing secretary reserves the right to change the date, time and venue of match, if found necessary.
15. The teams should bring their complete kit.
16. All participants are expected to maintain proper discipline and decorum at all times inside the school campus. The staff accompanying the team will be totally responsible for their team during their stay at Rajkumar College Campus.
17. Winners and 1<sup>st</sup> Runner-up and 2<sup>nd</sup> Runner-up will be awarded Trophies/Cups.
18. Each participant will be awarded a Certificate of participation at the Closing Ceremony.
19. All correspondence in regard to the Championship should be addressed to The Principal, Rajkumar College, Raipur.
20. THE DECISION OF THE CHAIRMAN & ORGANISING COMMITTEE IN ALL MATTERS OF DISPUTE WILL BE FINAL AND BINDING.
