# GENERAL INFORMATION

## Conference Details

The conference will be conducted from 25th to 26th April 2026 at Rajkumar College, Raipur.

## Eligibility

The conference is open to all high school students (Class VII and above).

## Rules of Procedure

The conference will strictly follow the conventional UNA–USA Rules of Procedure as prescribed by the United Nations.

Rules for unconventional committees, if any, may vary slightly and will be duly communicated to the delegates prior to the conference.

## Registration Fee

The registration fee for the conference is ₹2,000 per delegate.

## Transportation

Please note that no transportation facilities will be provided by the host institution.

## Further Information

All further details including the Committee Matrix, Background Guides, Accommodation Details, Position Paper Deadlines, Official Website Address, Executive Board Details, and other relevant information will be shared with the participating school upon confirmation of participation.

10 committees will result in 30 awards

Verbal mention – 2 per committee ( only certificate). Thus, a total of 50 awards will be given out in the whole MUN.



# MODEL CODE OF CONDUCT

Rajkumar College's Diplomatic Forum upholds the highest standards of international diplomacy simulation. This code ensures every delegate embodies professionalism, respect, and excellence across all committees.

## Core Principles

Delegates represent nations or entities with unwavering integrity. Uphold factual accuracy in speeches, resolutions, and negotiations—misinformation undermines the simulation. Maintain decorum at all times; personal attacks, disruptions, or unparliamentary language result in immediate point deductions or removal. Embrace inclusivity: respect diverse backgrounds, genders, abilities, and viewpoints, reflecting true global discourse.

## Dress Code Standards

Day 1: Indian traditionals

Day 2 – Western Formals

No casual wear, shorts, or open footwear.

- Accessories: id badge, placard, country flags, and the file provided must be carried. Minimal jewellery; no distracting elements.
- Rationale: Mirrors UN protocol, fostering gravitas from opening to closing ceremony.

## Punctuality and Attendance

- Arrive 15 minutes before daily sessions. Late entry disrupts proceedings.
- Full attendance is compulsory; prior secretariat approval required for absences. Devices on silent; no usage during sessions except research.
- Breaks for essentials only—return promptly to respect committee time.
- Misconduct towards OCs/volunteers/EBs will NOT be tolerated.

## Speaking and Decorum Rules

- Raise placard for Points of Order, Inquiry, or Yield.
- Speeches limited to allotted times (enforced by chair). Yield to chair, floor, or questions only. No interruptions; listen actively.
- Respect chair rulings as final—appeals via formal motion only.







## Committee Conduct Guidelines

- Moderated Caucuses: Seek chair permission before speaking. Maintain queue discipline.
- Crisis committees: classified directives handled confidentially. Resolutions drafted collectively; pre-writing banned. Voting: stand for ayes, abstain seated—electronic systems where applicable.
- Prohibited Actions:
  1. Physical contact, harassment, or intimidation.
  2. Unauthorized notes passed or technology hacks.
  3. Leaving committee without chair permission.
  4. Substance use or intoxication (zero tolerance).

## Research and Preparation Ethics

- Use verified sources only—cite during speeches when referencing facts. Plagiarism in working papers/resolutions disqualifies submitters.
- AI-generated content permitted for research but not speeches or papers (original phrasing required). Chairs verify authenticity randomly.
- The school will NOT provide internet/wifi connection. Internet devices will be allowed but on your risk. The school will not be responsible for any items lost.

## Awards and Integrity

- Awards based holistically: diplomacy (50%), research (20%), oratory (20%), decorum (10%). Self-nominations or campaigning prohibited.

## Chair and Secretariat Rights

- Chairs enforce code impartially, with discretion for unique situations. Violations escalate: Verbal warning → Point deduction → Suspension → Disqualification.
- Appeals to Secretariat post-event only. Code updates annually based on feedback.

All delegates sign: "I pledge to uphold RKC MUN's code, simulating diplomacy with honor. I commit to respect, excellence, and growth."
