Editorial : On August 15th, 1947 Jawahar Lal Nehru addressed our Nation and became the first Prime Minister of India as we celebrated our first day free of the British Empire. I would like to give you a brief background about this. India had been under the British control since the 18th century. The Indian independence movement was a number of events spanning a period of 1612 to 1947.

Around 1919, Mahatma Gandhi declared a "Satyagraha" meaning "devotion to truth" against the British government launching a nonviolent campaign of civil disobedience. Over the next 25 years Gandhi became the face of the Indian Independence Movement. Pt. Nehru, Gandhiji's protege and Mohd. Ali Jinnah also played a prominent role in opposing the British rule. In 1942, Gandhi led the Quit India Movement ordering the British out of the country.

While the world was disintegrating into violence and war, in the 20th century Gandhi taught the virtues of truth, non-violence and peace. Following the World War II, with India becoming ungovernable the British decided it was time to grant it Independence.

Lord Mountbatten was named the Viceroy of India and he determined that India should be partitioned, very unfortunately, into the dominions of India and Pakistan.

This 15th of August, 2020 India will celebrate 73 years of freedom. We should not take this freedom for granted. We must strive to become better citizens who will inspire and empower others.

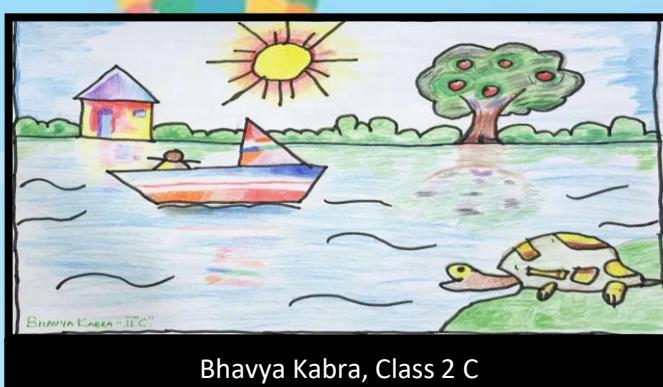


The school life

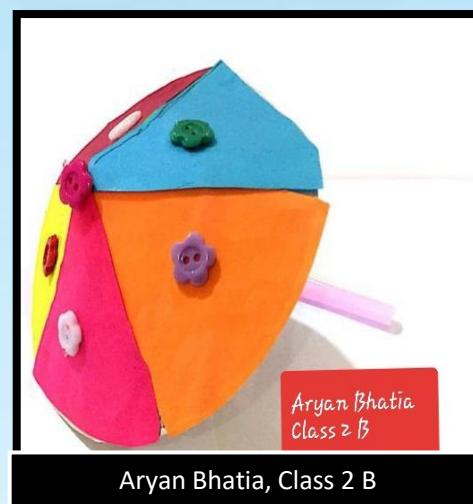
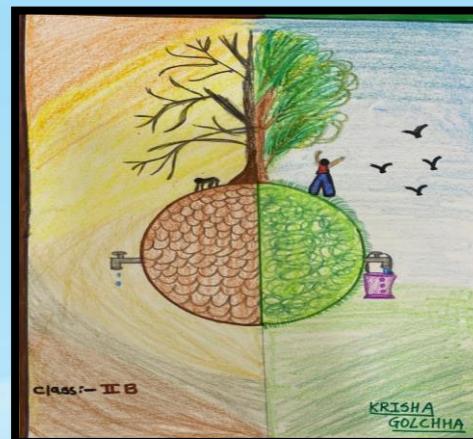
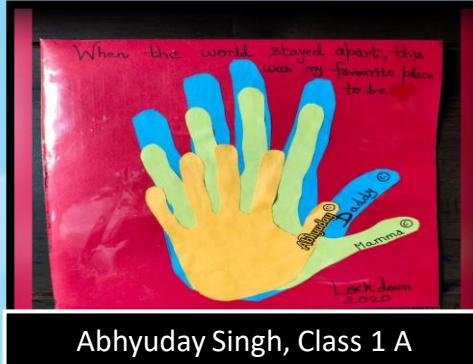
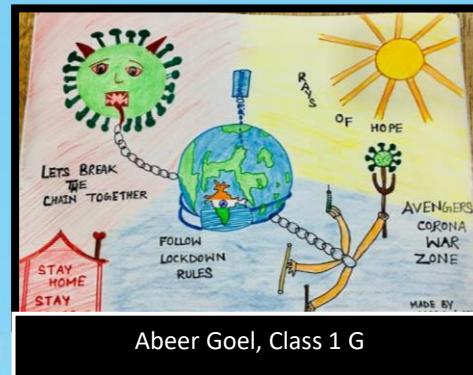
The joyful lockdown

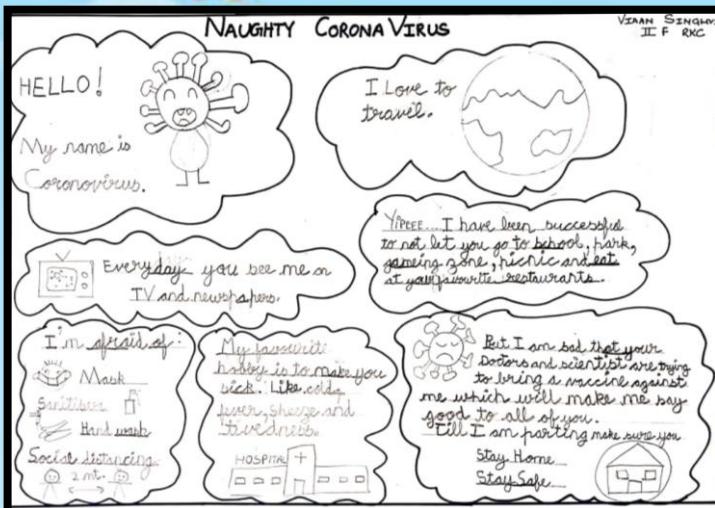
