## My School is my life

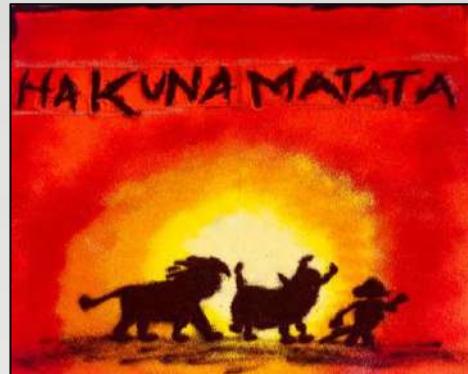

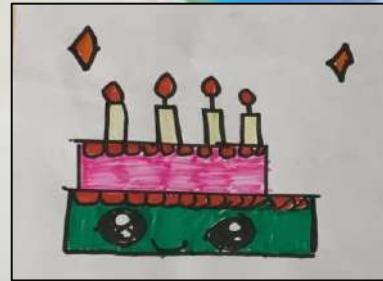

We should be thankful to the farmers by not wasting our food and have faith in God that these COVID times will be over soon.

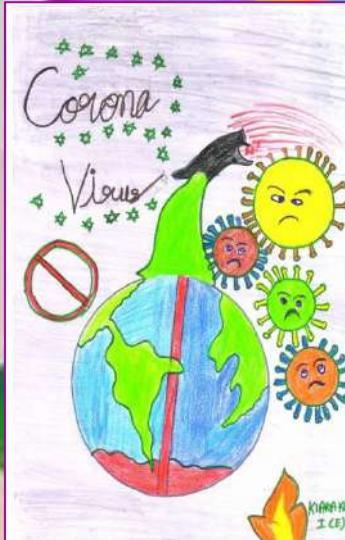

## Eggless Rose Cookies

### Ingredients:

Rice flour - 1cup  
Maida/all purpose flour - 1/2 cup  
Powdered sugar - 1/2 cup  
Sesame seeds - 1. tsp  
Cumin seeds - 1 tsp  
Coconut milk thick - 1 cup  
Salt a pinch  
Oil for deep frying

### Method:

- 1) In a bowl, add rice flour, Maida, powdered sugar, sesame seeds, cumin seeds & salt.
- 2) Now add coconut milk & Mix well till it is thick enough to stick the mould.
- 3) Heat oil & dip the mould in hot oil to heat.
- 4) Now dip the mould 3/4 in the batter then deep fry in hot oil.
- 5) Remove the mould from oil when the cookies are light brown and separate it with the help of spoon from the mould.

Repeat the process and enjoy the quick, fast, easy and delicious rose cookies.
