


A Pen Is Mightier Than A Sword

Cake For Teachers

Ingredients

- 3 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 1/2 cup powdered sugar
- 2 teaspoon baking powder
- 1 1/2 cup milk
- 2 teaspoon vanilla essence
- 1/2 cup cocoa powder



Method-

Step 1 - Begin by mixing sugar & butter. Whisk well until it turns light and fluffy with a whisker.


Step 2 - Put together the all-purpose flour, baking soda, and cocoa powder in the mixture. Add vanilla essence for a lovely smell.

Step 3 - Sprinkle some Maida on a greased baking tin. Line it with butter paper. Pour the mixture into the tin.

Step 4 - Place the baking tin in the microwave for 35 min under 180 degrees Celsius of temperature.

Step 5 - Insert a metal skewer/fork into the cake to check if it's ready.


विवान का नाम एशिया और इंडिया बुक्स ऑफ रिकॉर्ड में दर्ज



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
