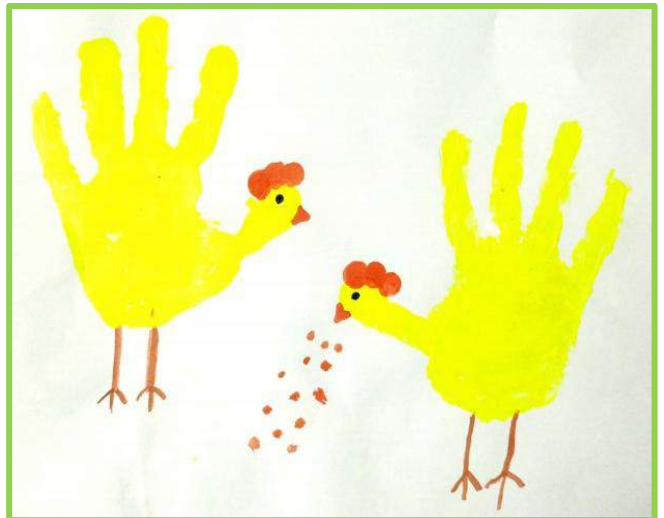

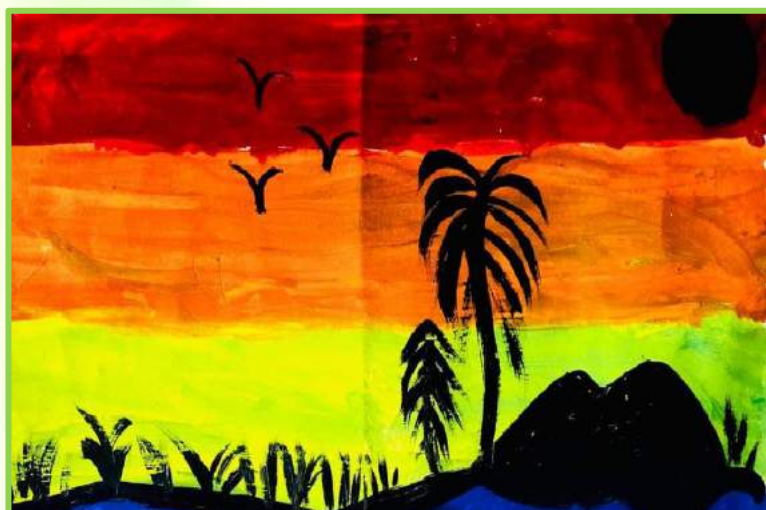

Lastly garnish with cheese and chilli flakes as toppings.



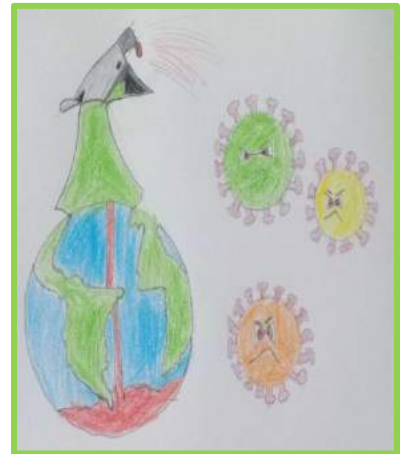
