SCIENCE ACTIVITY, CLASS - 3

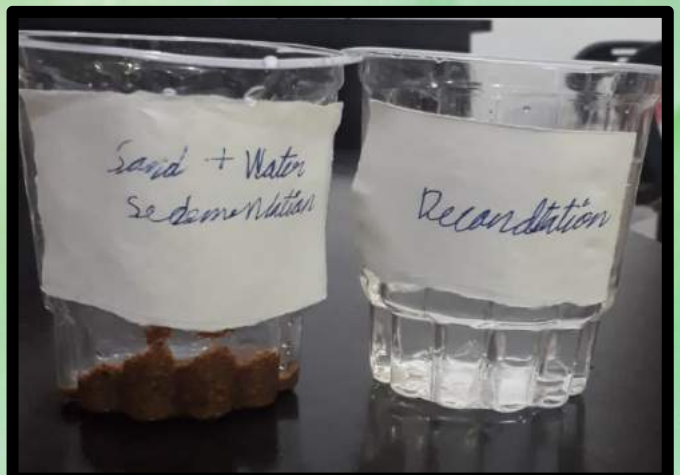
Online activity based on the Chapter Some Properties of Water.
Students performed various activity to explore the properties of water.



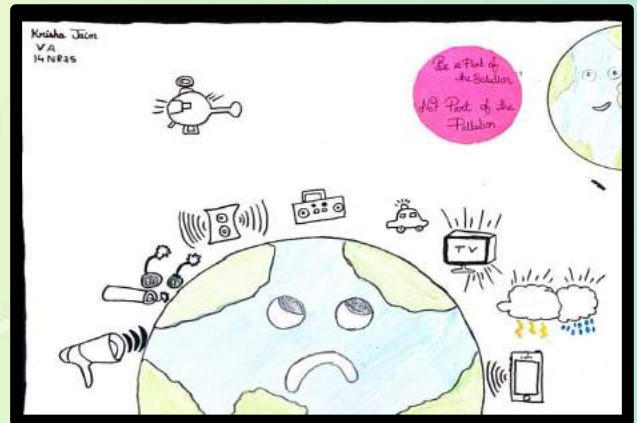
SCIENCE ACTIVITY, CLASS - 4

Students made posters and wrote a slogan on noise pollution to create awareness about environmental pollution.

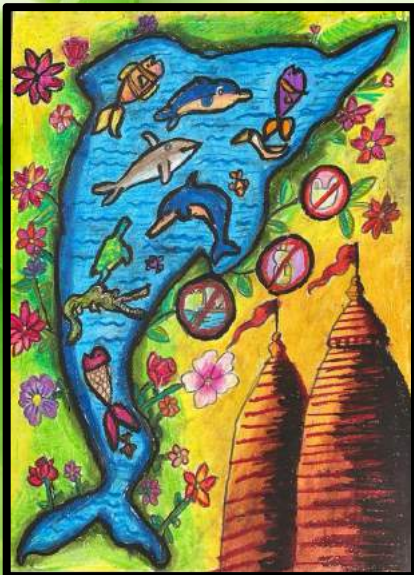


Our Young Achievers
