Now, just make others, all aware.

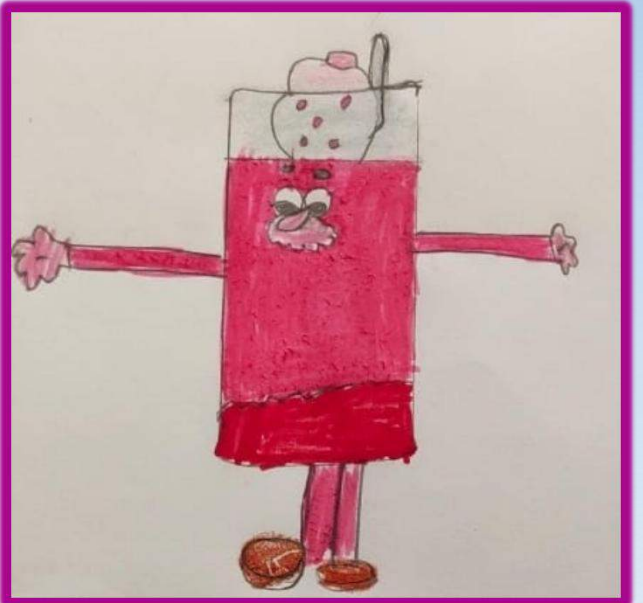
