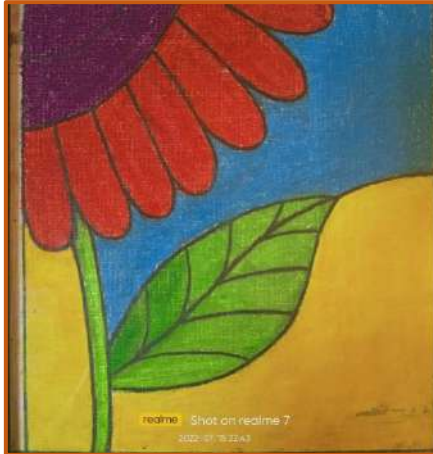
Sports

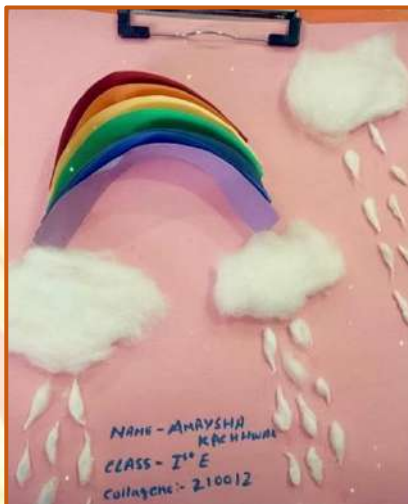

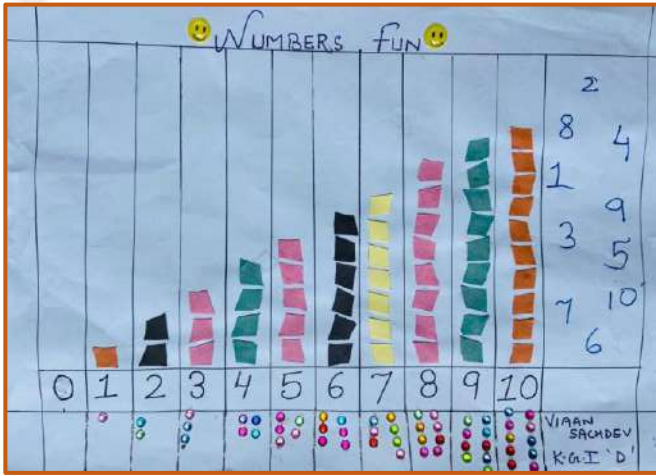

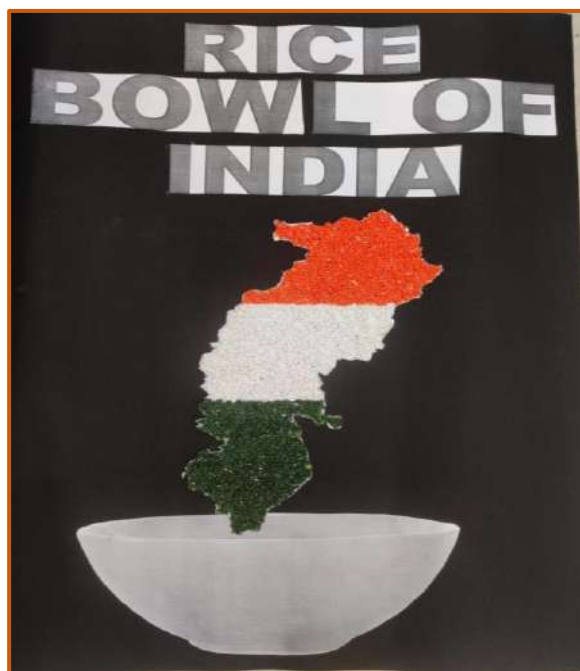
Save Soil

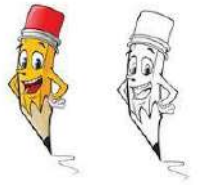

में भारत की जीत हुई।

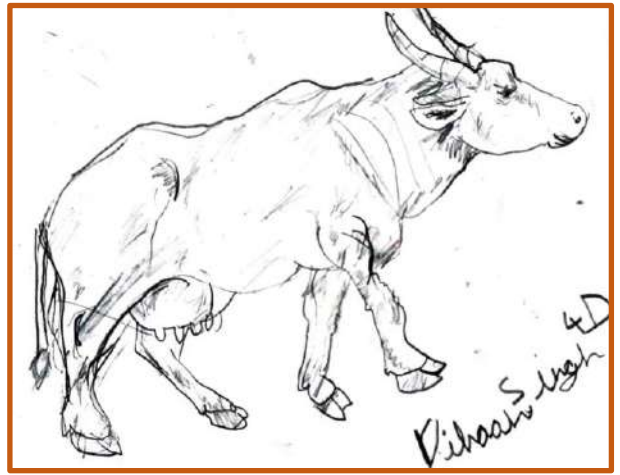

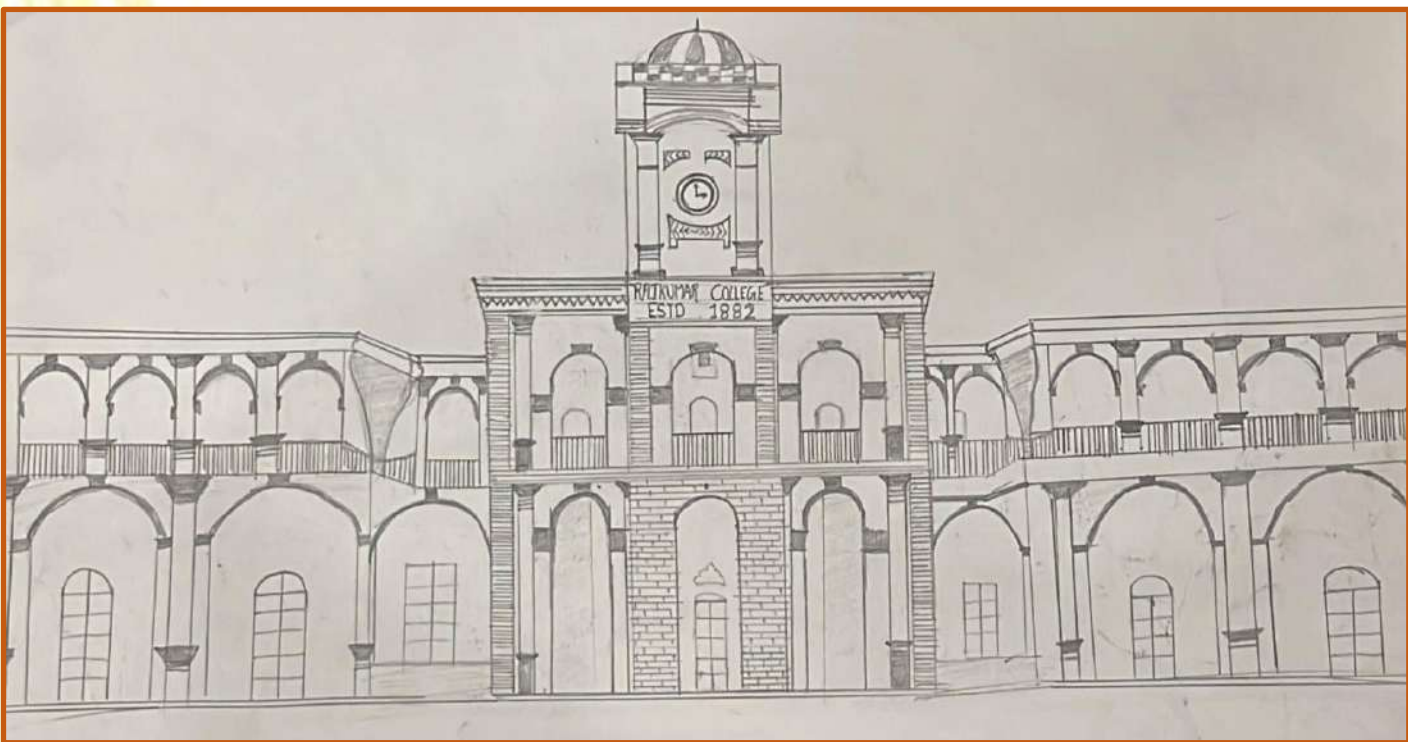

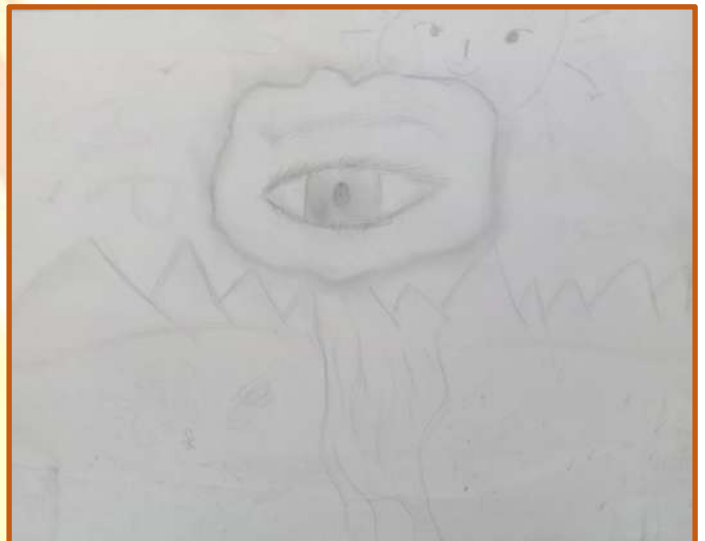
