A teacher is the captain of a class. She controls and manages the class and children just like the captain of a ship.


A teacher is the best guide in our school life. She helps us to build better character and to become better human beings.

Without a teacher, we would not be able to get knowledge and wisdom. Likewise, without the captain of a ship, nobody will be able to sail the way it should.





Teacher






Teachers' day
