Art Integrated Learning is a teaching and learning model that is based on learning through the 'arts'.

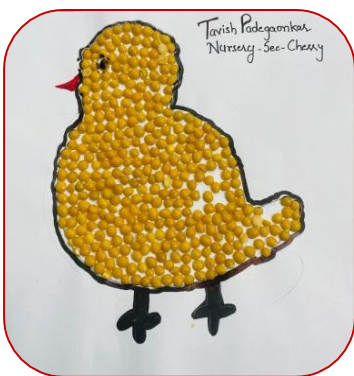

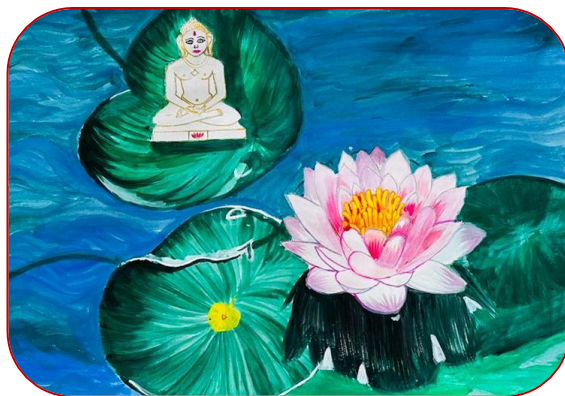
## Mother Earth

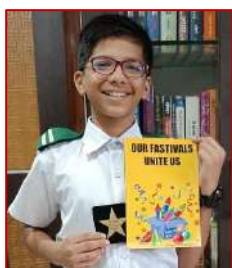
