Rajveer Ajwani Class II C, secured 2nd position in Inter School State Level Mega Chess Championship.



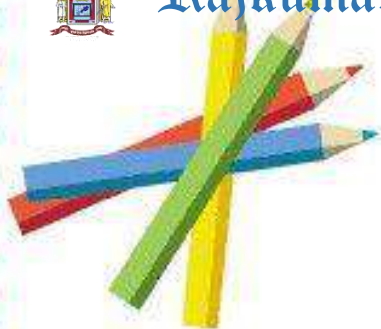
Leher Nihichlani of IV G, participated in group dance in All India Dance Competition held at Bhilai, their group bagged 2nd prize.
