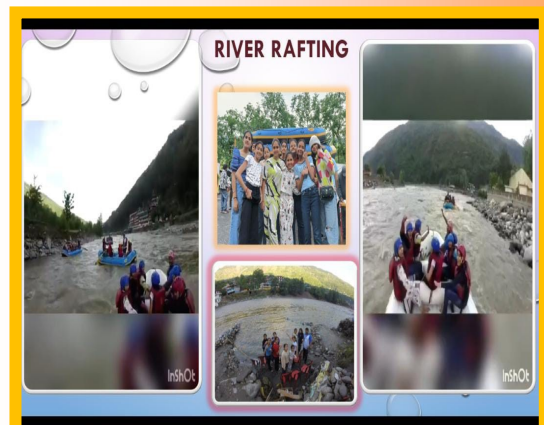
Manali Trip

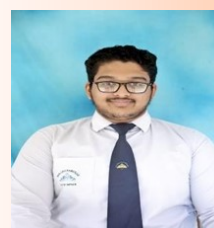
