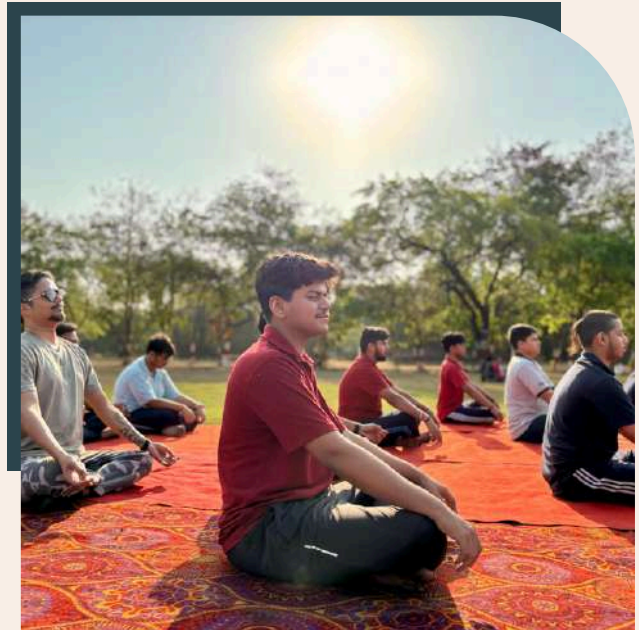

IPSC LEADERSHIP CONCLAVE

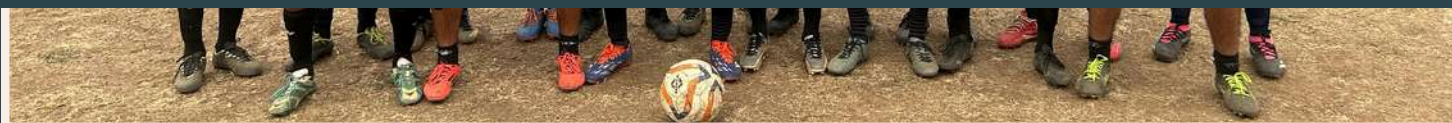

Aryan and Farhan impressed with their remarkable football skills and strategic play during the CISCE matches, standing out as key players and making their team proud with every move on the field.





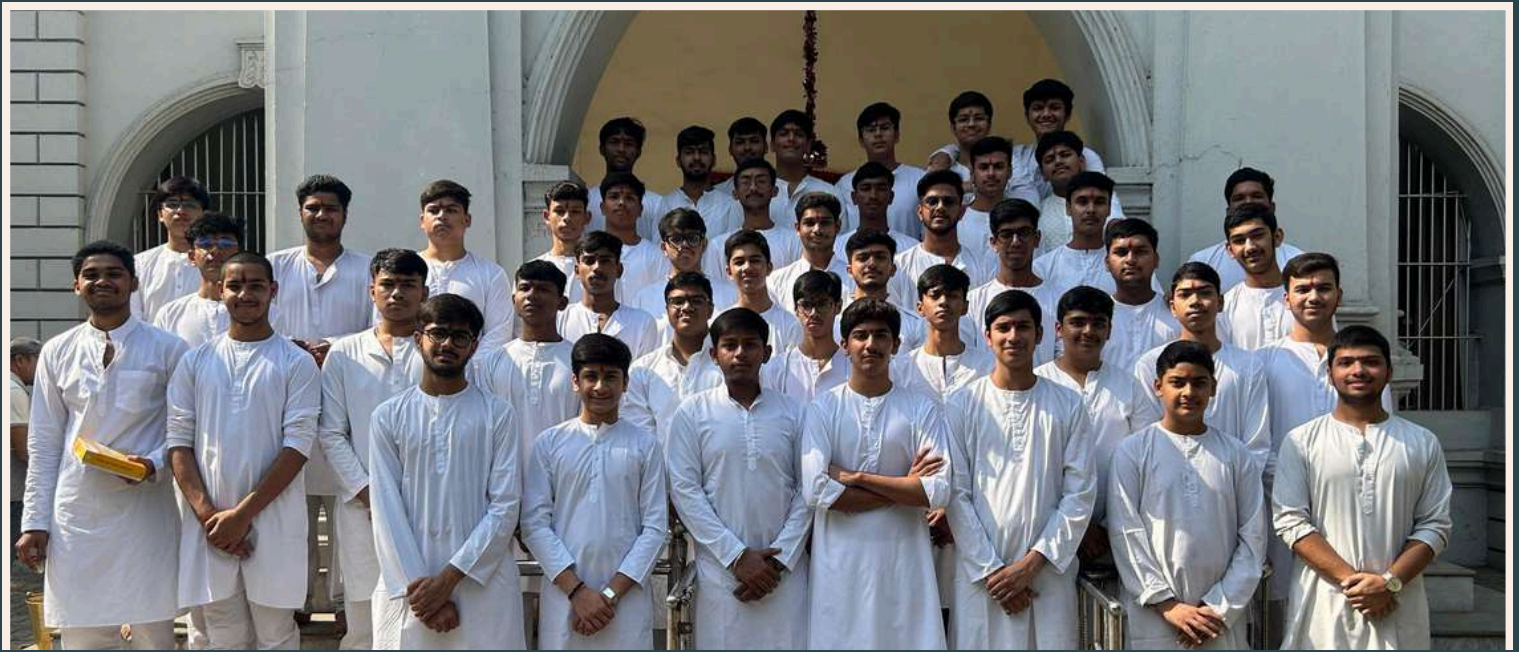
